REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS GENERAL CONCESSION SERVICES FOR ENTERPRISE STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Enterprise State Community College (ESCC) is soliciting sealed proposals for the exclusive provision of general concession services for contracted events held at the Jimmy H. Baker Center for the Arts ("Baker Center"), and athletic events at the Baseball/Softball Complex and the Lolley Gymnasium. The contract will be awarded for an initial one-year term, with the option to extend for up to four additional years provided no changes are made to the original agreement.

SCOPE OF WORK

The selected vendor will be responsible for the sale and distribution of non-alcoholic beverages, snacks, and general concession items during designated events. All operations must comply with applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations governing food and beverage service. The vendor will provide all personnel, equipment, and supplies necessary to deliver these services.

The selected responder shall be required to have Enterprise State Community College, the Alabama Community College System (ACCS) and the ACCS Board of Trustees named as additional insureds on its liability policies. (May be obtained after award is made.)

ESCC will select based on completeness and clarity of the proposal, understanding of the scope of work, prior experience, references, fees, insurance, and other factors which in judgment of ESCC staff might have an impact to the provider's ability to provide services to ESCC specifications of this RFP.

It is the proposer's sole responsibility to ensure delivery of its proposal by the deadline. ESCC does not accept late responses for any reason, including those due to postal or courier service delay.

PROPOSER'S RESPONSIBILITY

A proposer, by submitting a Proposal, represents and understands that:

- The proposer is familiar with the conditions under which the services defined in this RFP must be performed. The proposer possesses the capabilities, resources, and personnel necessary to provide efficient and successful service to the ESCC; and
- The proposer shall be solely responsible for all services provided. It is the responsibility of the proposer to verify the completeness of the requirement and its suitability to provide the services described in this RFP.

GENERAL TERMS

1. All responses become a matter of public record at award. ESCC accepts no responsibility for maintaining confidentiality of any information submitted with a response whether labeled confidential or not.
2. ESCC reserves the right to reject any or all responses and to waive informalities in the best interest of ESCC. ESCC reserves the right to not make any awards and re-issue this RFP at any time if it serves ESCC's best interest.
3. The successful proposer shall, at its sole expense, procure and keep in effect all necessary permits and licenses required for its performance of the requested work or service.
4. The proposer shall be required to complete a State of Alabama Disclosure Statement. Alabama Act# 2001-955 requires the disclosure statement to be completed and filed with all proposals, responses, contracts, or grant proposals to the State of Alabama in excess of \$25,000. Any changes to the status of the information on this form will require the submission of an updated form to ESCC.
5. All selected vendors are required to complete the Alabama Immigration Law Compliance documents and IRS Form W-9.
6. Verification of enrollment in the E-verify program will be required prior to any award to a vendor who employs one or more employees within the State of Alabama. Failure to provide documentation within 10 calendar days of notification will result in the rejection of your response. 7. ESCC reserves the right, for its convenience and without cause or penalty, to terminate any contract for services at any time with 30 days written notice. This provision may not be changed by subsequent contract.
8. Notwithstanding any other provision in this RFP, the proposing vendors acknowledge and agree that the terms and commitments contained herein shall not constitute a debt of the State of Alabama in violation of Section 213 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended by Amendment No. 26.
9. Any contract resulting from an award in connection with this RFP shall include the following terms:
 - a. This agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama without giving effect to any choice or conflict of laws, provisions, or rules (whether of the State of Alabama or any other jurisdiction) that would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Alabama.
 - b. It is further agreed that the terms and commitments contained herein shall not constitute a debt of the State of Alabama in violation of Section 213 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended by Amendment Number 26.
 - c. If any provision of this agreement shall contravene any statute or constitutional provision, either now in effect or which may be enacted during the term of this agreement, then the conflicting provision of this agreement shall be deemed null and void.
 - d. Contractor understands, acknowledges, and agrees that its sole and exclusive remedy for any claim which may arise from or relate to this agreement is to file a claim with the Board of Adjustment of the State of Alabama.
 - e. By signing this agreement, the parties affirm, for the duration of this agreement, that they will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire, for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of this agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting there from.
 - f. This agreement constitutes the sole and entire agreement of the parties to this agreement with respect to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous understandings, negotiations, and agreements, both oral and written, with respect to such subject matter.
 - g. In compliance with Act 2016-272, the parties hereby certify that they are not currently engaged in, and will not engage in, the boycott of a person or an entity based in or doing business with a jurisdiction with which this state can enjoy open trade.
 - h. This agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed to be one and the same agreement.
 - i. The Contractor shall provide all materials, supplies, workspace, personnel, and equipment that it deems necessary to perform the services provided for herein.
 - j. The relationship between the parties is that of independent contractors. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as creating any agency, partnership, joint venture, or other form of joint enterprise, employment, or fiduciary relationship between the parties, and neither party shall have authority to contract for or bind the other party in any manner whatsoever.
 - k. Contractor shall protect, indemnify, defend and hold harmless Enterprise State Community College, the Alabama Community College System, the Alabama Community College System Board of Trustees and their respective agents, employees, member, directors, officers, successors and assigns, from and against all claims, losses, damages,

and injuries, including but not limited to property damage, bodily injury or death, of every kind or character in any way arising from User's use of the facility or caused by or arising from the acts or omissions of User, but such indemnification shall not be applicable if the loss, damage or injury is proximately caused by the gross negligence or misconduct of Enterprise State Community College.

- l. In accordance with Alabama Act 2023-409, the contractor does hereby verify that, without violating controlling law or regulation, it does not and will not, during the term of the contract, engage in economic boycotts.
