FIND Books:

WebCat www.escc.edu → Select Library Link → Resources → ESCC Online Catalog

Through WebCat, you will find for each ESCC item:

- The holding library location
- The number of copies owned
- The format of the item ONLINE, sometimes, NONE,
- The year of publication
- Call Numbers Library of Congress EBSCO ebook Collection Accessed through WebCat Example entry:

#10	DG735.6 .S73 2002 EB	copies: NONE
	Society and individual in Renaissance Florence [electronic resource]	at: ESJCLIB
	Connell, William J.	pubyear: 2002

“NONE” or “ONLINE” indicates the copy is an electronic resource.

DG735.6 .S73 ← Call Number

2002 ← Publication year

EB ← Electronic Book

Select the VIEW button to access the title’s record.

Toward the bottom of the record, the “Electronic access” link is shown.

FIND ARTICLES:

Alabama Virtual Library www.avl.lib.al.us

Access periodicals, journals, and scholarly articles. Passwords are not required for on-campus and in state use. If you live out-of-state or close to another state line, you will need to contact the library for a username and password.

Databases include EBSCO, Academic OneFile, Opposing Viewpoints... Use WorldCat to assist in finding numerous resources held by other libraries and institutions.
