We hope that your kids are as excited as we are about Camp Weevil 2023! We are working hard to finalize all the plans for an exciting Camp Weevil this summer. We would like to answer as many of the questions or concerns you may have regarding dates of camp, early check-in, areas of drop off/pick-up, daily camp details, refreshments, and contact information as we can. Please see the listed below information:

**Camp Weevil Dates:** **Monday – Thursday, June 26-29**

**Early Check-In:** We highly encourage campers to take advantage of early check-in. This allows the campers to pick up their Camp Weevil bag, T-shirt, pick-up card, schedule, name tag, and campus map. Pick up dates and times will be **Thursday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> from 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.** then **Friday, June 23<sup>rd</sup> from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.** **Pick up location will be in Lurleen B Wallace Hall - Student Center -Community Room (Building #4 on map).** The first day of camp is always a little hectic so this early check-in is helpful for us, but especially for the camper and parents. PLEASE NOTE - When coming onto the campus, YOU WILL NEED TO ENTER THE COLLEGE FROM OUR BACK ENTRANCE (from George Wallace Drive). You may park in parking lot C for early check-in.

**Drop off/Pick-up:** Area of drop off and pick-up has changed from last year due to construction on campus. Please pay close attention to the map that has been included on the website as well as emailed and mailed to you. We hope everyone takes advantage of the early check-in. If not, we will have an area set up for campers to pick-up what they will need on the first day of camp. Campers MUST be dropped off and picked-up on the backside of the campus between the Lolley Gym and Forrester Hall – upper portion of parking lot D (traffic flow noted on the map in RED arrows to help ensure campers safety during drop off and pick up). All parents and/or designated adults (with parents' permission) should display the pick-up card in the window of the vehicle daily. **THIS AREA WILL BE THE ONLY DROP OFF AND PICK UP POINT ON CAMPUS. DO NOT ASK CAMPERS TO GO TO THE PARKING LOT FOR PICK-UP.** We will call campers down in order of car line.

**Every Day of Camp:** Campers should arrive (at the designated area) **NO EARLIER THAN 12:45 p.m.** **Please do not bring your child before 12:45 p.m. as there will be no supervision.** At approximately 12:55 p.m., children will begin heading to their first class. College personnel and camp volunteers will be stationed around campus before, during, and after classes to ensure all children find their way around campus. We ask that campers wear their camp t-shirt daily.

**Refreshments:** Refreshments will be provided; however, campers are welcome to bring daily refreshments. Please note that **they will be responsible for keeping up with their own snack.**
